

George Fox University Band & Orchestra Festival

Friday March 8th, 2024 from 8:00am-5:00pm

The George Fox University Band & String Orchestra Festival will be a State Qualifying event with certified judges. Bands, full orchestra, and string orchestras are invited to participate; a second band or second orchestra (whether full or strings) may only participate if space allows.

The cost of the festival is \$300 per band or orchestra.

NOTE: Prepayment is required (after 2 years of a change during Covid).

While we understand that most schools prefer 10am-2pm, we must fill out the morning and late afternoon times—your flexibility in these manners are appreciated! *It is expected that your students will stay late or come early to hear a minimum of 2-4 other performances.* Each group will have a 25 minute warmup, performance (25 for strings, 30 for band and full orchestra), plus a 25 minute clinic. Sight-reading *may* be available instead of a clinic if registered directors request it; however, with three classifications of ensembles in the Festival, this is logistically difficult.
