**Performance applicants in acting and directing** will have a 10-minute time slot for their audition and interview. The first three minutes will be designated for the audition, and the following seven minutes for the interview. Applicants should prepare two contrasting 90-second monologues (comic and dramatic, or classic and contemporary). The total time for both monologues should be no longer than three minutes. **Design / Technical and Stage Management applicants** will have a 20-minute time slot for their portfolio review and interview. Designers should bring a portfolio of materials representing their work (design statements, photographs, drafting, sketches, renderings, models, etc.) to the interview. Technical theatre, business or management students should prepare a narrative explaining your experience and interest in your particular fields of theatre. If materials are available, these students are encouraged to bring their portfolios as well.
