The George Fox University (GFU) Early College Dual Credit program exists to give students at partner high schools the opportunity to earn college credits without having to leave their high school campus. Our high school partners have worked with GFU faculty to create college level courses for your high school that will count towards a college degree. It's the best of both worlds! Frequently Asked Questions

What does "receive college credit" mean?

By enrolling yourself in dual credit courses at George Fox University, you will start to earn credits toward a college degree. The courses and your grades will be kept on record at GFU and you will be able to obtain a real college transcript for these courses once they are completed.

How does FERPA work in the higher education university setting?

In order for parents to inquire about their child's registration, enrollment, or grade information, their child must fill out a FERPA agreement located here. Please have your child fill out the form and send it to maugustin@georgefox.edu.

Does the college credit apply only to George Fox University degrees, or can it be transferred to other universities?

These are full college courses that can be applied to one of George Fox's 60+ majors and degrees. However, they may also be transferable to other accredited universities. We recommend contacting the university you plan to attend for details on their specific transfer credit policies.

How much do these courses cost?

\$75.00 a credit hour. Typically classes are either 3 or 4 credit hours.

How do I register? What is the deadline to enroll?

Registration will go live September 21st. Click here to register on our website.

- Registration for fall and year-long courses will be open until the end of October.
- Registration for Spring courses will begin January 2026.

Is there a certain grade I have to get to earn college credit?

Yes, to earn college credit, you will need to achieve a C- grade or higher. There will be no refund of course fees. This is one of the reasons we wait until halfway through the class to have you register with GFU.

How do I order my transcripts?

At the end of April, *you will receive account set up instructions along with your student ID.* Please keep this information. Once you set up your account, you will be able to log on and download unofficial transcripts. This will be helpful to give to your prospective universities. Once you are ready to order your official transcripts, simply go to www.georgefox.edu, type "order transcripts" in the search bar. It will take you to the Registrar's page for ordering transcripts. You can click here as well.

Can my parents or guardian inquire about my registration and/or grades?

Due to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), parents can not inquire about course or grade information unless there is written consent. This affords eligible students certain rights with respect to their education records. A student's FERPA rights go into effect once they are enrolled and have attended at least one class at George Fox University. Your student has the option to complete a FERPA Release Form granting George Fox University (GFU) permission to disclose information. Please click here for more information.
