Direct Admit Overview

Students who are currently attending George Fox University and meet all of the following requirements are offered Direct Admission to the College of Nursing. Students must indicate their [Intent to Pursue Nursing](#) to be placed on the Direct Admit List. Failure to complete the Intent to Pursue Nursing Form may result in not being evaluated for the current admission cycle.

Running Start students: Running Start students must complete at least two semesters (minimum of 12 credits per semester) at George Fox University before being considered for Direct Admission. Running start students with one semester (minimum of 12 credits per semester) at George Fox University and no additional college credits will be considered for General Admission. If a Running Start Student has additional college credit (earned after graduation from high school), they will be considered a transfer student and must apply via George Fox University.

Direct Admit Requirements

The Direct Admission Program requires students to meet all of the following expectations of academic and personal achievement while completing their freshman and sophomore years. Adherence to all these expectations determines a student's ability to maintain direct admission status for the GFU College of Nursing.

- Maintain a minimum of 3.00 Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) every semester.
- Maintain a minimum of 3.00 Cumulative Science GPA, which includes: CHEM 150: General, Organic and Biological Chemistry, BIOL 221: Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222: Human Anatomy and Physiology II, and BIOL 367: Microbiology.
- Students must receive a "C" grade or higher in all nursing prerequisite courses. A "C-" or lower in any prerequisite course is not considered a passing grade and the course must be repeated.
- Must be continuously enrolled full-time (at least 12 credits per semester) and complete the four most recent semesters at GFU.
- Must not have repeated or withdrawn from any nursing prerequisite course(s).
- Must have completed all nursing prerequisite courses at GFU or while in high school.
- Must meet the stated expectations for the GFU student body, as described in the GFU student handbook for being in good standing.
- Must have a social security number or visa number (per OSBN).
- Submit an [Intent to Pursue Nursing at George Fox University](#) form
 - **The form will be available on January 20th, 2025, and will close on April 25th, 2025.**
 - Failure to complete the Intent to Pursue Nursing Form may result in not being evaluated for the current admission cycle.

The requirements listed above pertain to this particular admission cycle. If more than 60 direct admit students qualify, some may be offered direct admission for a spring start.
