

Program Compliance Requirements

After accepting an offer of admission into a College of Nursing (CON) Program at George Fox University (GFU), students must complete these program compliance requirements.

Screening	Description		
Background Check	Ordered through the assigned vendor.		
Drug Screen	A 10-panel and fentanyl urine drug screen ordered through the assigned vendor.		
Immunizations	Description		
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)	2 doses of MMR vaccine	OR	Positive individual titer for Measles, Mumps, and Rubella
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses of Varicella vaccine	OR	Positive titer for Varicella
Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)	Tdap vaccine within the last 10 years	OR	Tdap and Td booster if Tdap is more than 10 years old
Hepatitis B	3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine	OR	Positive surface antibody (HBsAb) titer for Hepatitis B
Influenza (Flu)	Annual Flu vaccine	OR	GFU CON Flu Declination Form
	Note: Flu vaccine must be received by October 1 annually.		
COVID-19	COVID-19 vaccine(s)	OR	GFU CON COVID-19 Declination Form
Tuberculosis (TB) Screening	TB Blood Test: QuantiFERON-TB Gold or TSpot	OR	2-Step TB Skin Test
	GFU Tuberculosis (TB) Questionnaire	AND	CDC TB Initial Risk Assessment
	Note: Students who test positive must submit a negative chest x-ray with provider interpretation within the past five years.

BLS Certification	Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Provider Certification through the American Heart Association (AHA). Renewed every two years.
