Note: In order to be eligible to apply, you must complete these courses with a grade of a "C" or better. Only one science course and one nursing prerequisite course retake will be counted. A withdrawal counts as an attempt.

All other courses will be completed while in the nursing program. Applications are completed through NursingCAS. Science courses are in BOLD below.

2023-2024 Requirements for Direct Admission Status for the GFU College of Nursing

The Direct Admission Program requires students meet all seven of the following expectations of academic and personal achievement while completing their freshman and sophomore years. Adherence to all these expectations determines a student's ability to maintain direct admission status for the GFU College of Nursing.

- 1. Maintain a 3.00 minimum Cumulative Science GPA, which includes the following courses: CHEM 150: General, Organic and Biological Chemistry, BIOL 221: Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222: Human Anatomy and Physiology II, BIOL 367: Microbiology.
- 2. Maintain a 3.00 minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) in all nursing prerequisite classes which includes: MATH 180: College Algebra, COMM 111: Communication in Society, PSYC 150: General Psychology, WRIT 111: Caring for Words, PSYC 240/MATH 240: Statistical Procedures, PSYC 310: Lifespan Development, THEO 380: Ethics, NURS 220: Nutrition, CHEM 150: General, Organic and Biological Chemistry, BIOL 221: Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222: Human Anatomy and Physiology II, BIOL 367: Microbiology.
- 3. Students may not receive a C- grade or lower in any of the above prerequisite courses.
- 4. Must be continuously enrolled as a full-time student (at least 12 credits per semester) and complete the four most recent semesters at George Fox University.
- 5. Must not have repeated or withdrawn from any nursing prerequisite courses.
- 6. Must have completed all nursing prerequisite courses at GFU or while in high school.
- 7. Must meet the stated expectations for the George Fox University student body, as described in the GFU student handbook.
- 8. Must have a social security number or visa number (per OSBN).

Continuation into the BSN cohort

Direct Admission students who fulfill the above expectations are guaranteed acceptance into GFU College of Nursing Program.

Direct Admit students are notified in mid May, after completing their sophomore year, whether they have satisfactorily met the above criteria and can proceed into the GFU College of Nursing program.

Due to limited enrollment capacity, the GFU Nursing Program reserves the right to make annual modifications of the above criteria as needed. Prospective applicants will be notified of changes in the above policy.

2023-2024 Requirements for General Admission Status for the GFU College of Nursing

George Fox University Pre-Nursing students, with the exception of those students qualifying for Direct Admit status, must meet ALL of the following requirements of academic and personal achievement while at George Fox University to be eligible for the General Admission status to the George Fox College of Nursing.

- 1. Earn a minimum 2.9 Cumulative Science GPA, which includes the following courses: CHEM 150: General, Organic and Biological Chemistry, BIOL 221: Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222: Human Anatomy and Physiology II, and BIOL 367: Microbiology. Courses must be completed by the end of spring semester before a Fall or Spring admission. Students with a Science GPA below a 2.9 will not be considered for admission to the GFU College of Nursing.
- 2. Earn a minimum 2.9 Cumulative GPA in all nursing prerequisite classes which includes: MATH 180: College Algebra, COMM 111: Communication in Society, PSYC 150: General Psychology, WRIT 111: Caring for Words, PSYC 240/MATH 240: Statistical Procedures, PSYC 310: Lifespan Development, THEO 380: Ethics, CHEM 150: General, Organic and Biological Chemistry, BIOL 221: Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222: Human Anatomy and Physiology II, and BIOL 367: Microbiology. Students with a cumulative GPA below a 2.9 will not be considered for admission to the GFU Nursing program.
- 3. A C- grade or lower in any prerequisite course is not considered a passing grade for the nursing program.
- 4. Must be continuously enrolled as a full-time student (at least 12 credits per semester) and complete the four most recent semesters at George Fox.
- 5. Retakes will be evaluated and may affect admission decisions.
- 6. Must have completed all nursing prerequisite courses at GFU or while in high school. A one course exception will be considered.
- 7. Must meet the stated expectations for the George Fox University student body, as described in the GFU student handbook.
- 8. Must have a social security number or visa number (per OSBN).

General Admission Application Process

Pre-Nursing students are notified in early spring whether they have satisfactorily met the above criteria and are eligible to proceed with the General Admission to the GFU College of Nursing. Admission to the GFU College of Nursing is a competitive process, and qualifying for the General Admission status does not guarantee admission into the BSN cohort. The GFU College of Nursing has two cohort admissions per year: the Fall semester (August) and the Spring Semester (January).

Due to limited enrollment capacity, GFU College of Nursing reserves the right to make annual modifications to the above criteria as needed. Prospective applicants will be notified of changes in the above policy.

2023-2024 Requirements for Transfer Admission to George Fox College of Nursing

Transfer applicants to GFU College of Nursing must meet the following requirements:

- Earn a minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA in the following science prerequisite courses (must have been completed in the last 7 years): CHEM 150: General, Organic, and
 Biological Chemistry (must include all three components), BIOL 221 Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222 Human Anatomy & Physiology II (if taking quarter credits,
 must take third course to complete series), BIOL 367 Microbiology.
- 2. Earn a minimum of 3.0 cumulative in all nursing prerequisite courses: MATH 180: College Algebra, COMM 111: Communication in Society, PSYC 150: General Psychology, WRIT 111: Caring for Words, MATH 240: Statistical Procedures, PSYC 310: Lifespan Development, THEO 380: Ethics, NURS 220: Nutrition Essentials, CHEM 150: General, Organic, and Biological Chemistry (must include all three components), BIOL 221 Human Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 222 Human Anatomy & Physiology II (if taking quarter credits, must take third course to complete series), BIOL 367 Microbiology.
- 3. Must earn a C grade or higher in ALL prerequisite courses. A grade of C- or lower will not be accepted.
- 4. Retakes and withdrawals will be evaluated and may impact admission decisions.
- 5. All prerequisite courses must be completed prior to admission.
- Must apply via NursingCAS and upload official transcripts to NursingCAS.
- 7. Must submit an essay via NursingCAS.
- 8. Must attend an online group interview.
- 9. Will be scored on the following additional experience according to the rubric:
 - a. Essay
 - b. Online group interview
 - c. Volunteer experience
 - d. Work experience (unpaid childcare or caregiving experience qualifies)
 - e. Previous Bachelor or Transfer degree
 - f. Military service
 - g. Resume uploaded
