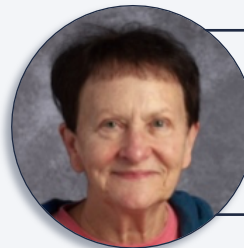
Wondering what it's like to participate in the Science Outreach Program? We asked teachers to share their experience.
